NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

1. The removal of the clock movement: weights to be lowered and dismantled for removal. The movement to be washed, cleaned, and polished at the workshop. Restoration of the dial.
2. Remedial work to make the spire safe due to the corrosion of the current iron ring. The current iron ring to be cut out in short sections and then replaced by a stainless steel spider framed ring, bolted into the stonework.
3. Stonework repair and repointing works to west gable, north east vestry, and other high level areas. On the west gable 2m of coping to be removed and the kneeler stone to be fixed with a stainless steel cramp, rebbed and pointed. At the north east vestry repointing, stonework reset, stonework cleaned, and new concrete footing provided and laid. The chancel east gable to have copings reset and the kneeler fixed as the west gable. Further high level repointing as accessible and required.

2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
